## **Village Council Meeting January 7, 2014**

Mayor Brunas called the meeting to order at 7:30 pm with the following councilors present: Ken Weisgarber, Don Ditson, Jolene Siemens, and Ralph Stobbe. Tax payer Tim Eveleigh was present.

- Minutes of the regular meeting on December 2<sup>nd</sup>, special meeting on December 9<sup>th</sup>, bank rec and Waterworks Monthly Log Records were approved.
- Council remuneration for 2015 will be:
  - \$1200/annum for councilors
  - \$1600/annum for deputy mayor
  - \$1800/annum for mayor
  - \$25 for required or expected to attend meetings (min 1/2hr. to 3hrs.)
  - \$50 for required or expected to attend meetings (min 3 hrs.)
  - Meals and mileage shall be at the same rate as the Provincial Public Service Commission.
- Council acknowledged the List of Lands in Arrears for 2015.
- The Administrator's time-in-lieu was approved to be carried over into 2015.
- The Village is extending the Agreement for Impoundment with the Regina Humane Society for the year 2015.
- The Village will be purchasing bookshelves to be placed in the Community Hall foyer for the Little Free Library.
- The new Water and Sewer Rate Bylaw was approved by the Municipal Board. A penalty of 2% per month will be applied to all utility accounts that remain outstanding 30 days past the date of issue, starting with January's consumption.
- Big thanks to Scott Goebel for getting the rink ready just before Christmas.
- The next recycling pick-up is Tuesday, January 27, 2015.
- There will be a freezer meal workshop Thursday, January 15, 2015.

Next regular council meeting will be **February 11, 2014** at the Grand Coulee United Church.
