Village Council Meeting April 7, 2015

- Minutes of the regular meeting on March 3rd were approved as were the payment of accounts, the bank reconciliations, balance sheets, statement of receipts & payments, and the Waterworks Log Records.
- The 2014 Audited Financial Statements prepared by Dudley and Company LLP were approved as were the transfer of reserve funds.
- We will sadly be losing our Part-time Admin Assistant. Carling got full-time employment in Saltcoats. Congrats to her!!!
- Council has requested a meeting with Sask Water to discuss allocation of water.
- The congregation spoke to council regarding having a celebration in joint effort with the Village for the new Joint Use Facility (church and office). The celebration will take place on June 21. More details to follow.
- A neighbouring acreage has asked to tie into the Sask Water/Grand Coulee water line. This has been tabled until a meeting can take place between the Village and Sask Water to sort out a few concerns/issues.
- A concern forth made regarding driveway access approaches on Maple Ave being too high. Council has tabled this until they can get grades/elevations.
- The Administrator is going to look into the possibility of expropriating land for a drainage easement on the east side of Centennial Dr.
- A special meeting will be called in the coming weeks to pass the 2015 Budget. A reminder that the 2015 taxes will be due September 30.
- The land swap between for the rec site has been pushed back a couple weeks.
- The Come-And-Go Library is now open. If you have some books you would like to drop off or would like to borrow a book or two, you can access the library during regular office hours (9am-4pm, Monday-Friday). The hall doors will also be open Saturday mornings between 8:45am-10:00am. If you are interested in volunteering some hours so that the library can be open during off hours please contact the office.
- **YEARLY COMPLIANCE REPORT FOR DRINKING WATER**
Saskatchewan Environment "Drinking Water Quality and Compliance Regulations" requires that at least once a year waterworks owners (Village of Grand Coulee) provide notification to consumers of the quality of water produced and supplied, as well as information on the performance of the waterworks in submitting samples as required by the "Permit to Operate Waterworks". This is to notify, pursuant to these regulations, that a summary of the Village of Grand Coulee's water quality and sample submission compliance record for the January 1st 2014 to December 31st 2014 time period is now available at the Village office. This information can also be seen online at www.saskh20.ca.
