### Village Council Meeting June 2, 2015

- Minutes of the regular meeting on May 5<sup>th</sup> were approved as were the payment of accounts, the bank reconciliations, balance sheets, financial statements, and Waterworks Monthly Log Records.
- BLS Asphalt has been rewarded the tender for the Railway Ave improvement project. Council will be meeting with them and Stantec in the coming week. Work should begin the week of June 15. [Be prepared for traffic detours on Railway Ave.](#)
- The Village is going to be trying other dust control products along various spots throughout the community.
- A resident from Centennial Dr. expressed his frustration with the speed of vehicles and asked council to reconsider putting a 3-way stop at the intersection of Assiniboia Ave and Centennial Dr. Council instructed the Administrator to ask the residents on Maple, Centennial, Park and English Bay if they would be in favour of the 3-way stop. If the majority come back in support council will pass an amended traffic bylaw.
- It looks like we are going to be having an extremely dry summer and dust is going to be a huge issue. The slower you drive the less dust you kick up. For everyone's health and well-being [slow down on all roads, not just the interior ones.](#)
- The Administrator's holidays have been approved: July 23-24 and August 14-23.
- 2015 Tax Notices have been mailed. Taxes are due SEPTEMBER 30. A 1.5% penalty will be added to the unpaid portion the first day of each month of the current year. A 15% penalty will be added to all arrears as of January 1.
- Recycling pick-up is June 16.
- The office will be closed July 1.
- Next council meeting July 7.
