Village Council Meeting November 4, 2014

- Minutes of the regular meeting on October 7 were approved as were the payment of accounts, the bank reconciliations, balance sheets, financial statements and the Waterworks Monthly Log Records.
- Council authorized the proceedings to request title for the lands with arrears pursuant to the Tax Enforcement Act for the following properties: Lot 5, Block 8, Plan #AD841, Lot 16, Block 4, Plan #55058, Lots 16-17, Block 3, Plan #55058, and Lot 18, Block 11, Plan #101939463.
- Houses with utility arrears will be receiving registered letters informing them that if their utility arrears are not paid in full they will be transferred to and form part of their 2014 municipal taxes. 2014 property taxes are due December 31, 2014.
- Council asked the Administrator to look into the option of charging monthly interest on outstanding utility bills.
- Council rejected the request for a 3-way stop sign at the corner of Assiniboia Ave and Centennial Dr.
- Administrator's holidays were approved for January.
- Grand Coulee will be laying a wreath at this year's Remembrance Day Service in Pense. Additionally we will be making a \$100 donation to the Pense Legion.
- The Administrator was authorized to send out a Letter to Remedy regarding a property with overgrown weeds. If the weeds are not cleaned up within 2 weeks the Village will hire the job out and bill back to the property owner.
- There will be an Open House at the office and church on the same day as the Trade Show, November 15. Come and meet some council and see the new office and board room.
- Next recycling pick-up will be December 2.
