

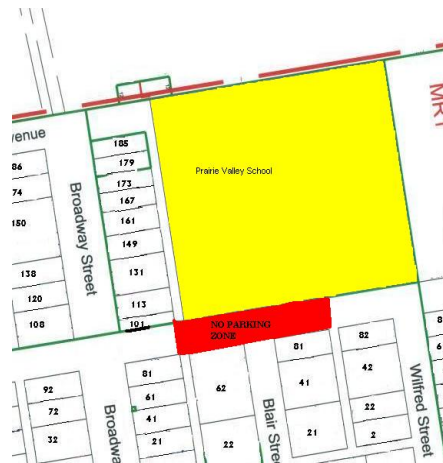

### Village Council Meeting September 3, 2013

- Minutes of the regular meeting on August 6<sup>th</sup> were approved as were the payment of accounts, the bank reconciliations, balance sheet and the financial statements.
- The Village has engaged Stantec to do the Phase 1 Environmental Site Assessment for the northern portion of Parcel Z within NW 15-17-21 W2M (north of the current school boundaries).
- The Village issued the Construction Completion Certificate for the Sanitary Sewer upgrade as recommended by Stantec.
- The Administrator is going to present a proposed amendment to the Traffic Bylaw at the next meeting in October. The amendment will have a “No Parking” zone from 8:00am to 5:00pm, Mon-Fri, along the north and south sides of Assiniboia Ave, running from alley to alley in front of the school zone area. The Village has consulted with the school and this is what they recommended to try and help with the congestion during school hours. Teachers will still be able to park in their assigned parking. Your cooperation to help keep the kids safe will be greatly appreciated.



- Council and the church board agreed to accept Wascana Presbytery proposal. The Village is going to consult with their lawyer to have an agreement drawn up.
- Municipal Reserve 2 should be having trees planted sometime this week or next. Big thanks to Larry Smart for all of his help. The shelter belt on the north west end of town will be extended as well.
- September 30 is the last day to receive 5% discount on your municipal portion of the 2013 property taxes.
