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## **Village Council Meeting November 5, 2013**

- Minutes of the regular meeting on October 1<sup>st</sup> were approved as were the payment of accounts, the bank reconciliations, balance sheet and the financial statements.
- Second and final readings on the Official Community Plan and Zoning Bylaw amendments were given.
- Council authorized the proceedings to request title for the lands with arrears pursuant to the Tax Enforcement Act for the following properties: Lots 2-3, Block 1, Plan #55058, Lots 23-24, Block 6, Plan #AO3760 and Lot 35, Block 13, Plan #101939463.
- Council decided to purchase an additional back-up generator and connections so that in case of an emergency, the town office will still have power. The lift station's back-up generator is now fully functional.
- Houses with utility arrears will be receiving registered letters informing them that if their utility arrears are not paid in full they will be transferred to and form part of their 2013 municipal taxes. 2013 property taxes are due December 31, 2013.
- The rec board and council will be meeting in the coming weeks to discuss PVSD comments regarding the draft agreement.
