Village Council Meeting February 11, 2014

- Minutes of the regular meeting on January 7th were approved as were the payment of accounts, the bank reconciliations, balance sheets and the financial statements.
- Council acknowledged the 2014 Tax Enforcement List and that it be advertised in the Regina Leader Post in accordance with the Tax Enforcement Act. Unless the arrears and costs appearing opposite the land and title number in the ad are fully paid by April 16, 2014, an interest based on a tax lien will be registered against the land.
- The council agreed to the Memorandum of Understanding between the Village and PVSD regarding the proposed land swap.
- Doug Cramer and Kelly Turcotte made a presentation to council regarding a "Savhanah Turcotte Memorial Park". Doug and Kelly proposed that the park could be partially funded by themselves and fundraising and awareness campaigns focusing on anti-bullying, teen suicide, cyber bullying and mental health awareness. The park committee is going to discuss and make a recommendation to council.
- Residents spoke with council regarding the No Parking Zone on the north side of their property. The Administrator is going to meet with the residents to try to come to some agreement that would satisfy themselves and council and make a recommendation to council.
- Water and sewer rate increase has been tabled until the City of Regina has finalized their rate increase.
- Council tabled Stantec's proposal regarding engineering services for topographical survey and design for site grading of the proposed rec site until the agreements have been signed by the developers.
- Council discussed the 2 proposals that were submitted by VPM and Quantum Construction regarding the general contracting of the church renovations. Mayor Brunas and Councillor Scott are going to meet and discuss the possibility of general contracting the renovations ourselves.
- Mayor Brunas is going to contact the B.Fenrick and ask for a couple of changes be made to the design. Once the design is finalized council will meet with the Church to discuss.
- Office will be closed Feb 21-25.

- Longtime resident Ron Hight passed away on Friday, February 7, 2014. Ron and his wife Louise moved to Grand Coulee in 1961. Ron served 2 terms as councilor for the Village and volunteered countless hours. A service for Ron will be at 1pm on Saturday, February 15 at Speers Funeral Home. Ron was 82 years old.
- On Monday, February 10, 2014 Jack Oglesby, another long-term community member passed away. Jack and his family first moved to Grand Coulee in 1961. Since then Jack has been involved one way or another with the Village and Church. The last scripture Jack did was at the Remembrance Day Service in Pense on November 11, 2013. A service for Jack will be at 10am on Friday, February 14 at Speers Funeral Home. Jack had just celebrated his 91st birthday.
