Village Council Meeting August 5, 2014

- Minutes of the regular meeting on July 8th were approved as were the payment of accounts, the bank reconciliations, balance sheets, financial statements, and July's Waterworks Monthly Log Records.
- A discretionary Use application for a home based business as well as an accessory building the size of 780ft² was approved.
- The foreman obtained his Class 1 Certificate in Waste Water Collection and Waste Water Distribution.
- Residents on Centennial Dr. expressed concerns regarding the drainage easement behind them.
- Residents on Burton St. expressed concerns regarding the depth and width of the ditch on Burton St. Additionally, they are concerned about some of the culverts that were put in, possibly too high. Council agreed to have Stantec come to shoot levels to make sure everything is where it should be at. Council agreed to have an arborist come and look at the trees that may have been damaged due to the ditch work. The Administrator is going to talk to Double K about building up the shoulders of the road on the north end of Burton St.
- An RCMP Officer came and talked with council regarding concerns of speeding and vehicles neglecting to stop at the Stop Signs. He said they would try to set up more traffic projects here but could not make any guarantees. He also wanted the residents to know that they themselves can make a statement on people failing to stop at the Stop Signs. All you need is time of day, location and a description of the vehicle. If you are willing to make a statement to the police, the police can place a charge based on that.
- The park on the south west end of town had a 2" water source bored in as well as an access approach put installed.
- The proposed Rec Site (east of the school) subdivision was approved by Community Planning.
- A reminder that the Village office is now at the church (102 Railway Ave). There is no drop box for cheques however you are able to slide cheques in between the 2 doors (with the open and closed sign). Please do not leave cash.
- The office will be closed August 15-22.
