Village Council Meeting November 3, 2015

- The Village is considering making application to transition to Town status. The Village Administrator will be developing the timeline and process. The Municipalities Act will provide direction and Village residents will be kept informed as the village makes this transition
- The Administrator will be surveying the community regarding frequency of garbage and recycling pick-ups.
- Following extensive research into play structures for the new park, the Playground Committee has selected a Little Tykes play structure.
- As per the Municipalities Act, excessive outstanding utility bills may be added to annual taxes. Ratepayers who have excessive outstanding water/sewer balances owing, will be receiving a letter advising them of the outstanding balance and the action that will be taken.
- Council passed a motion to amend the current budget to reallocate funds.
- Council gave first reading to the Sale of Dedicated Land Bylaw. A public hearing will be held on Tuesday, December 1, 2015 at 7:00pm. Feel free to contact the office or stop by if you have any questions.
- The Village will be looking at getting estimates to have the sewer main lines cleaned out on an every other year basis.
- Office closed Wednesday, November 11th, 2015 in honour of Remembrance Day.
