Automated External Defibrillator (AED)

- An AED is a lightweight, portable device that delivers an electric shock through the chest to the heart. The shock can potentially stop an irregular heart beat and allow a normal rhythm to resume following sudden cardiac arrest.
- AEDs make it possible for more people, from children to adults, to respond to a medical emergency where defibrillation is required.
- Did you know that our community has 3 AEDs? The first responders have one, there is one at the school and one at the new skate shack which is accessible 24/7.
- Grand Coulee is part of the Regina Qu'Appelle Health Region PAD program.
