A YEAR IN REVIEW

2018 was a year of changes, adjustments and tidying up loose ends around the community. The Town focused the majority of the summer on continuing with road improvements and beautification. Meadow Park had a sign donated (in loving memory of Meadow McElravey), picnic and table benches installed and a picnic shelter built. The skating rink and shack are now 99% complete and the Town has a new slogan "Your Friends Live Here" on 2 new signs.

The Rec Board also had a very busy and successful 2018. They did a great job bringing community members together by hosting numerous Friday Fun Suppers and canteen nights throughout the summer. They put on yet again another great Harvest Hoe Down and a Winter Festival which had horse pulled sleigh rides. The Rec Board organized dance classes, Tae Kwon Do, yoga, Easter activities, Christmas caroling, movie nights and Halloween parties (one for kids and one for adults). Not only did the Rec Board organize events and programs, they also subsidized events and programs. In 2018 they donated to the Caps Hockey Classic where all the proceeds raised go towards Grand Coulee/Pense Minor Hockey, they subsidized 58 Grand Coulee kids for flag football, put money in for the football uprights at Stewart Nicks School, subsidized craft supplies for the Sparks/Brownies which has 21 girls enrolled, provided funding for Hockey Dryland training at the outdoor rink in Grand Coulee, and purchased much needed outdoor picnic tables.

2019 Assessment Roll is now open

Notice was given on January 4, 2019 that the assessment roll for the Town of Grand Coulee for the year of 2019 has been prepared and is open to inspection in the office of the assessor from 9:00am to 12:00pm and 1:00pm to 3:00pm on the following days: Monday to Friday, January 4, 2019 to February 8, 2019. A bylaw pursuant to section 214 of *The Municipalities Act* has been passed and the assessment notices have been sent as required.

Any person who wishes to appeal against his or her assessment is required to file his or her notice of appeal, accompanied by a \$50.00 appeal fee which will be returned if the appeal is successful, with: The Assessor, Town of Grand Coulee, Box 72, Site 200, Grand Coulee, SK S4P 2Z2, by the 8th day of February, 2019.
